 - Open discussions encouraged participants to share their experiences, ask questions, and build solidarity.

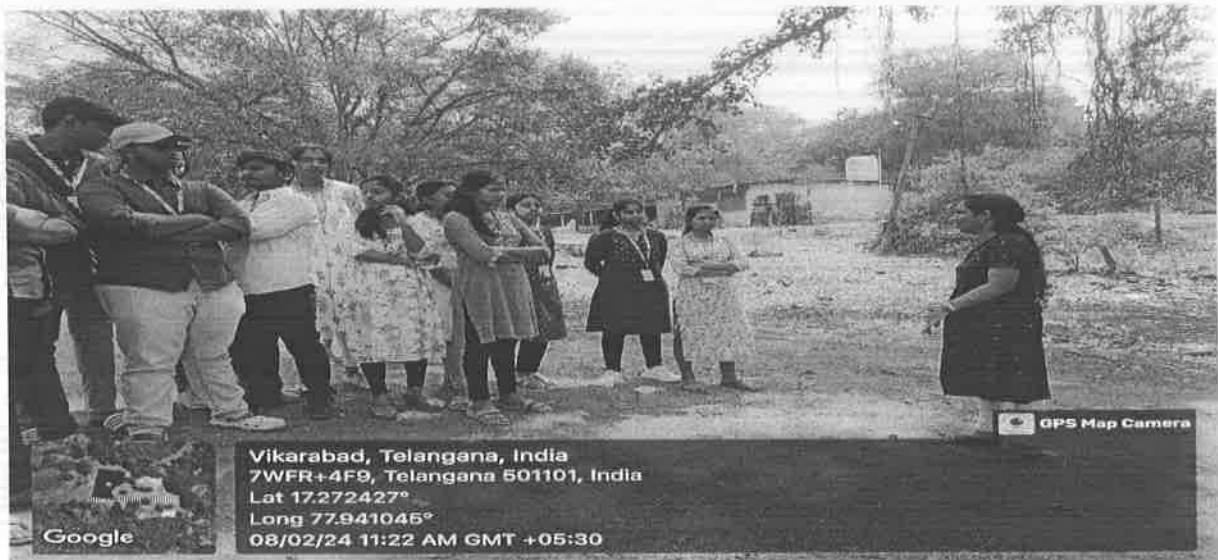
